SEQ RESTRICTIONS EXTENDED

The Queensland Government has extended COVID-19 restrictions (including the mask mandate) in 11 South East Queensland Local Government Areas for at least another week (Friday, 23 July 2021).

CONTACT TRACING

Earlier today, Queensland Health updated its exposure site list and included a Sunshine Coast location.
