CONTACT TRACING

Sundale Retirement Community residents are being reminded to check the Queensland Health website daily for the latest COVID-19 information, including current contact tracing alerts and related public health advice.

- Brisbane, Longreach and Gladstone domestic airports

Monday 12 July

- Flight QF2331 Gladstone to Brisbane
- Flight QF2374 Brisbane to Hervey Bay
- Flight QF2375 Hervey Bay to Brisbane
- Brisbane, Gladstone and Hervey Bay domestic airports.

The above listed preliminary contact tracing locations in Queensland were announced this morning. Information will be updated, added to and clarified, throughout today on the Queensland Health website.

CLUBHOUSES / HUBS

Sundale Clubhouses and Hubs will remain open.

Any persons entering a Sundale Clubhouse / Hub MUST:

- 1. Accurately complete the screening questions
- 2. Undergo a temperature check

You are not permitted to enter a Sundale Clubhouse / Hub if you answer yes to any of the screening

questions or if your temperature is more than 37.5 degrees.

3. Check in using the Check In Qld app (open the app and scan the QR code to register your visit)

Once inside, please:

- Maintain social distancing
- Stay at least 1.5 metres away from others
- Wear a mask when you cannot physically distance
- Practise hand hygiene
- Practise respiratory hygiene

Sundale will continue to work with Queensland Health and make responsible, considered decisions to help minimise the threat of COVID-19 entering Sundale.
