COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) update

As a valued member of the Sundale community, I wanted to provide you with an update and outline Sundale's current approach to managing the COVID-19 situation.

EIGHT -DAY LOCKDOWN

The Queensland Government's lockdown of South-east Queensland has been extended until 4pm Sunday (8 August 2021).

During the lockdown of 11 local government areas (which includes the Sunshine Coast) people will only be able to leave their homes for four reasons:

- obtaining essential goods
- essential work, school or childcare
- exercise with only one person from outside the household
- caring for a vulnerable person or seeking medical treatment or a COVID-19 vaccination or test

Obtaining goods or exercising will be restricted to within 10 kilometres of your home.

Funerals and weddings will be restricted to 10 people.
