COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) update

As a valued Sundale team member, I wanted to provide you with an update and outline Sundale's current approach to managing the COVID-19 situation.

SUNDALE CARE CENTRES — NEW RESTRICTIONS

Queensland Health has declared the Brisbane City, Moreton Bay and Gold Coast Local Government Areas (LGAs) Restricted Areas for the purposes of the Residential Aged Care Direction (No.8).

Sundale team members who have been to the Brisbane City, Moreton Bay or Gold Coast LGAs since 19 September must notify their manager immediately (prior to entering any Sundale facility or building).

CARE CENTRE VISITORS

Family and friends who have visited Brisbane City, Moreton Bay and Gold Coast LGAs at the relevant times will not be permitted entry to a Sundale Care Centre.

Instead, they can visit loved ones residing in a Sundale Care Centre in a designated visiting area. All visitors must wear a mask, sanitise their hands before entering and leaving the designated visiting area and practice physical distancing.

CONTACT TRACING

Sundale team members are being reminded to check the Queensland Health website prior to any shift for the latest COVID-19 information, including current contact tracing alerts.

Sundale team members who have been to any of the listed locations at the relevant times, must follow the health advice and notify their manager immediately (prior to entering any Sundale facility or building).

Sundale will continue to work with Queensland Health and make responsible, considered decisions to help minimise the threat of COVID-19 entering any Sundale facilities.
