COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) update

As a valued Sundale team member, we wanted to provide you with an update and outline Sundale's current approach to managing the COVID-19 situation.

MASKS

As of 1am tomorrow (Saturday, 18 December 2021), the Queensland Government has made masks mandatory across Queensland in the following locations:

- In shops and retail centres
- Hospitals and **aged care**
- On public transport
- In rideshare vehicles
- Airports and planes

The mask mandate will be reviewed once 90% of eligible Queenslanders are double dosed.

The current mask mandate does not include offices, including Sundale HQ.

COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

The Queensland Government's vaccine mandate is now in place and means only fully vaccinated visitors (and those with vaccine exemptions) are permitted to enter Sundale's care centres.

From this morning visitors will be asked to show their immunisation status on arrival.

Unvaccinated people will be unable to:

- Visit vulnerable settings, including hospitals, **residential aged care**, disability care accommodation, and prisons.

There will be some exceptions for medical treatment, end-of-life visits, childbirth and emergency situations.

CONTACT TRACING ALERTS

The escalating threat of COVID-19 in Queensland means it is essential Sundale team members check the [Queensland Health](#) website prior to any shift for the latest COVID-19 information, including current contact tracing alerts and related public health advice.

Sundale team members who have been to any of the [listed](#) exposure venues at the relevant times, must follow the health advice and notify their manager immediately, prior to entering any Sundale facility or building.

BOOSTER SHOT

Sundale team members are being reminded to organise a booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine as soon as possible.

You can book a booster dose if it has been 5 months or longer since your second dose of COVID-19 vaccine. You can [book](#) or [walk in](#) at any clinic offering COVID-19 vaccines, you do not need to return to where you got your primary course of COVID-19 vaccine.

Sundale will continue to work with Queensland Health and make responsible, considered decisions to help minimise the threat of COVID-19 entering any Sundale facilities.
