COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) update

As a valued Sundale team member, we wanted to provide you with an update and outline Sundale's current approach to managing the COVID-19 situation.

CONTACT TRACING ALERTS

Sundale team members are being reminded to check the **Queensland Health** website prior to any shift for the latest COVID-19 information, including current contact tracing alerts and related public health advice.

Sundale team members who have been to any of the <u>listed</u> exposure venues at the relevant times, must follow the health advice and notify their manager immediately, prior to entering any Sundale facility or building.

The list now includes two low risk contact* locations on the Sunshine Coast.

*Low risk contacts

If you have been to a **low risk contact** location at the relevant times, you are considered a low risk contact and must do the following:

- 1. get tested at your earliest convenience but you do not need to quarantine until you receive a negative test result
- 2. continue to monitor for symptoms, if you become symptomatic get tested and isolate until you receive a negative result.

QUEENSLAND RESTRICTIONS AT 80% DOUBLE-DOSE VACCINATION

The State Government has confirmed that a host of restrictions will be lifted on 13 December 2021, as 80% of Queensland's eligible population will be fully vaccinated.

However, there will be restrictions on people who are not fully vaccinated.

RESTRICTIONS FOR UNVACCINATED PEOPLE

Unvaccinated people will be unable to:

• Visit vulnerable settings, including hospitals, **residential aged care**, disability care accommodation, and prisons. There will be some exceptions for medical treatment, end-of-life visits, childbirth and emergency situations.

Sundale will continue to work with Queensland Health and make responsible, considered decisions to help minimise the threat of COVID-19 entering any Sundale facilities.
